the drug trade to take hold in Pittsburgh.

Nightingale has extensive public speaking experience, including from his time as a prosecutor, when he trained police officers in matters of evidence collection. He has been a guest on KDKA Radio, KDKA Television, The DVE Morning Show, WRCT Radio, WKQV Radio and is quoted often in the Pittsburgh Post-Gazette and Pittsburgh Tribune Review.

Nightingale currently runs a law practice that includes both state and federal courts, at the trial and appellate levels, and involves everything from simple drug possession to federal R.I.C.O. prosecution.
