Anthony Cincotti says he was initially attracted to a career in law enforcement because of the opportunity to serve his community. Anthony worked at Lovelock Correctional Center for 13 years as a Senior Correctional officer with the Nevada Department of Corrections. Lovelock houses approximately 1600 inmates of all custody levels. While at Lovelock, Cincotti spent time as a training officer and instructor.

While working in corrections, he earned an education in the human costs of drug laws, the high financial costs associated with prohibition and incarceration, and the complete lack of results brought about by the drug war.

Today, Cincotti is retired from law enforcement and works as a realtor in Cape Coral, Florida.
