Billy Murphy is a former judge and practicing attorney. He's spent over thirty years practicing law, including three years as a judge on the Circuit Court for Baltimore City, the highest Maryland trial court. Making history comes naturally to Murphy. His father, William H. Murphy, Sr., was one of the first African-American judges in Maryland. His great-grandfather founded the Afro-American Newspaper. His sister, Laura Murphy, is a top lobbyist for the American Civil Liberties Union and heads their Washington, D.C. office.

Murphy has handled cases in the U.S. Supreme Court and the state and federal courts of ten states, as well as in the United Kingdom.

Murphy founded a private legal practice in Baltimore, Falcon Murphy, and specializes in defense in birth injury, carbon monoxide poisoning, criminal defense, internet privacy, medical malpractice, personal injury, products liability, among others. He has defended an presided over numerous high profile civil and criminal cases.
