LeRoy Washington spent 34 years as a probation officer, including 25 years as a federal probation officer in two districts; the Central District of California, Los Angeles and the Western District of Washington, Seattle. He began his career with the Riverside County Probation Department in 1972 and was hired as a federal probation officer 8 years later. Throughout his career he worked all facets of the federal probation system, including pretrial services, supervision, and the presentence investigation. During his time as a pre-sentence investigator, LeRoy was part of the initial rollout of the U. S. Sentencing Guidelines implemented as part of the 1984 Sentencing Reform Act, drastically modifying and enhancing criminal penalties for possession and sale of drugs.

After retiring in 2004 LeRoy worked as a contract investigator for the Department of Defense doing background investigations, retiring in 2016. LeRoy currently resides in Hawaii along with his wife of over 47 years. He has three children and seven grandchildren.
