Silvestre Tanenbaum began his law enforcement career in 2009 as a Patrol Officer for city of Carrollton, Texas, where he conducted general patrol investigations and drug investigations. He served search warrants at houses suspected of manufacturing methamphetamine, assisted with surveillance for gang investigations, and provided backup to secure the perimeter for S.W.A.T. teams. In 2007, Tanenbaum joined the U.S. Army as a Logistics Manager, where his responsibilities included managing the lifecycle of military equipment, from

procurement to delivery. Tanenbaum also cultivated relationships with external organizations to ensure on-time delivery of medical and sustainment supplies to soldiers.

Tanenbaum suffered a back injury while serving overseas in the Army. He subsequently left law enforcement and the military to join the tech sector, where he currently works as a Product Manager for a software development company in Dallas.

Having been born and raised in Puerto Rico, Tanenbaum is fluent in Spanish. Tanenbaum is a graduate of University of North Texas, where he studied Public Affairs. He currently resides in the Dallas area with his wife and four children.
