Lucy Lang began her legal career in 2006 as an assistant district attorney with the Manhattan District in New York. Her duties included leading multi-year wiretapping investigations, complex gang and murder trials, and appellate cases. She later served as Special Counsel for Policy and Projects and Executive Director of the District Attorney's in-house think tank, the Manhattan D.A. Academy. Under her direction, the academy became a leader in the development of best prosecutorial practices. She also ran Manhattan's Intelligence Driven Prosecution Symposium and inaugurated an in-prison college class designed for incarcerated students to study criminal justice alongside prosecutors.

In 2018, Lang left the District Attorney's Office and became the Executive Director of the Institute for Innovation in Prosecution (I.I.P.) at John Jay College. Her work with I.I.P. revolves around the development of new and improved prosecutorial practices. She holds a B.A. in political science from Swarthmore College and a J.D. from Columbia Law School, where she is a Lecturer-in-Law. She serves on the Board of Managers at Swarthmore College and was previously Editor-in-Chief of the Journal of Gender and Law at Columbia Law School. She was named a Rising Star by the New York Law Journal in 2015, was selected as a Presidential Leadership Scholar in 2017, and is a Term Member of the Council on Foreign Relations.
