Detective Tearany Hardaway (Fmr.) began her law enforcement career in 2010 as an officer with the Daytona Beach Police Department. She has experience in street-level narcotics investigations, crisis intervention, and hostage negotiation. As a Person Crimes Detective, she was responsible for providing support to victims during the investigative and judicial process in the aftermath of a crime. She has trained law enforcement on subjects including law, human diversity, and interpersonal communications as a certified basic law enforcement instructor, and taught newly hired department staff on how to perform their duties effectively as a field training officer.

Hardaway left policing in 2017. She holds a B.S. in business administration from Bethune-Cookman University, law enforcement certification from the Daytona State College School of Emergency Services, and expects to graduate from Florida A&M University College of Law in 2020.
