Joseph Surman began his legal career in 2007 as a judicial clerk with the Middlesex Vicinage Court in New Jersey. In 2008, he became an assistant prosecutor with the Middlesex County Prosecutor's Office. He worked as a special legal advisor for the Middlesex County Special Operations Response Team and provided on-scene legal assistance during high-risk Special Weapons and Tactics (S.W.A.T.) operations. He also worked within the Special Victims Unit, where he was assigned cases involving sexual offenses and child abuse.

In 2016, Surman left Middlesex County Prosecutor's Office and transitioned to private practice. He is a member of the New Jersey State Bar, Pennsylvania State Bar, and Middlesex County Bar Association. He holds a B.S. in criminal justice and a J.D. from Rutgers University and Rutgers University School of Law respectively.
