Steve Miller's 20-year career in law enforcement included positions as a police officer, detective, and sergeant. He began with the United States Air Force as a Security Policeman responsible for weapons systems security and anti-terrorism on US Air Force bases in the US and abroad. He subsequently served in Saudi Arabia at Dhahran Air Base during Operations Desert Shield and Desert Storm. After leaving the military, he joined the Canton Police Department in Michigan.

Steve has extensive experience working as a team member on two different SWAT teams, first at Hickam Air Force Base Emergency Services Team for 3 years, then as member/operator on the Western Wayne County Special Operations Team.

Steve was certified as a Pressure Point Control Tactics (PPCT) Use of Force instructor for the Canton Police Department in 2004. From then until retirement, Steve instructed annual certification classes for department personnel in the proper use of force as well as reviewing all incidents involving use of force as they occurred. As a sergeant with the Canton Police Department, Steve was the first line of review in all civil asset forfeiture cases that occurred during his shift.
