Sheriff David Hutchinson began his career as a police officer with Bayport Police Department in Missouri. In 2006, he transferred to the Metro Transit Police Department where he worked on the Northside of Minneapolis and the surrounding suburbs. Hutchinson also served as a sergeant, supervising the Crisis Intervention Training (CIT), Community Engagement Team, and the Peer Support Program.

Hutchinson was elected as the Sheriff of Hennepin County in 2018 and was re-elected in 2019. Hutchinson implemented the Tri-Wellness Unit,

a wellness program which includes a department psychologist, a peer support network, and several chaplains that help maintain the staff's mind, body, and spirit. In addition, he created two new units, the Community Outreach Division and Criminal Intelligence Division, to better evolve with law enforcement's changing responsibilities.

David Hutchinson has a BA in criminal justice from Alexandria Technical & Community College. Sheriff Hutchinson is also a Crisis Intervention Training coach.
