Assistant District Attorney Sean Powers began his career in 2012 as a defense attorney for his own law office, The Law Office of Sean Powers. Shortly thereafter, ADA Powers began working with the Harris County District Attorney's Office as an assistant district attorney. He has served as a prosecutor in Reintegration Court, focusing on the rehabilitation of people with low level felony drug charges. He has also served in the 176th District Court, prosecuting murder, aggravated sexual assault, aggravated robbery, and aggravated kidnapping cases.

Currently serving as Number Two Prosecutor in the Intake Division, Sean Powers continues to maintain a positive trial record. Assistant District Attorney Powers holds a JD from Suffolk University Law School. He is a former member of the Harris County Criminal Lawyers Association and a current member of the Texas District and County Attorneys Association.
