## Officer Jillian Snider (Ret.) New York Police Department Monroe, NY

Jillian Snider began her career as a patrol officer with the New York Police Department in 2006. Throughout her career, Officer Snider served in various units including street narcotics enforcement, anti-crime, field intelligence, vice operations, and special operations. She is a highly decorated officer, receiving several awards for her service, including the NYPD Police Commissioner's Roosevelt Award.

In her time in the Special Operations unit, Officer Snider trained police

officers and drafted all precinct tactical plans. In addition, she compiled and analyzed all Special Operations data for CompStat, DomStat (Domestic Violence), ChocStat (Narcotics), and GunStat. Officer Snider also served as a primary liaison for external grants from non-profit organizations geared towards curtailing youth drinking and preventing substance use.
