Special Agent Kristofor Healey (Fmr.) Department of Homeland Security Montgomery, TX

Special Agent Kristofor Healey (Fmr.) began his career in law enforcement in 2007 as an Immigration Enforcement Agent in Raymondville, Texas. He served as the flight operations officer and primary U.S. Government envoy on ICE reparations missions, returning thousands of MS-13 gang members to Central America. In 2009, Healey was selected by ICE to serve as a Contracting Officer's Technical Representative for the Department of Homeland Security's Office of Acquisition Management. In 2010, he became a Special Agent for the Department of Homeland Security Office of the Inspector General. In that position, he was assigned to a HIDTA Task Force

in South Texas where he worked on narcotics trafficking and public corruption cases involving Mexico based cartels. He later led the largest tele-fraud case in U.S. history, Operation Outsource.

Special Agent Healey began serving as an adjunct instructor at the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center in 2016. Widely recognized as a subject matter expert on tele-fraud schemes and elder exploitation, he taught investigative techniques relating to transnational call center operations and case studies related to border corruption.

Healey is a court certified expert on money-laundering and wire fraud. He received the National Award for Investigative Excellence from the Federal Law Enforcement Officers Association in both 2017 and 2021. He is also the author of two books, *Indispensable: A Tactical Plan for the Modern Man* and *In Valor: 365 Stoic Meditations for First Responders*.
