Carrie Roberts earned her B.A. in Sociology and Criminal Justice from Colorado State University. Her first career after graduation was with the Colorado Department of Corrections at a high security penitentiary.

Roberts later went through the Sheriff's Training Institute where she received her Colorado Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) certification and became an Arapahoe County Sheriff's Deputy working

in corrections. Roberts subsequently transitioned from active law enforcement to the private sector where she began the nation's first mystery shopping company focused exclusively on the cannabis industry to help dispensary operators focus on maintaining compliance and setting standards.

Roberts is currently a senior consultant with Medicine Man Technologies, a business consultancy specializing in the legal cannabis industry, where she provides cultivation and dispensary facility tours, educational presentations, and intelligence for law enforcement and legislative officials in states where marijuana legalization is unfolding. Roberts also sits on the standards creation board for Foundation of Cannabis Unified Standards (FOCUS), an independent, non-profit, third party source for the creation of standards in the cannabis industry.
