Ramon de la Cabada began his career as an Assistant State Attorney with the 20th Judicial District of Florida in 1991. During his two years as an ASA, he prosecuted a variety of crimes ranging from DUI to white collar and violent crime.

In 1999, de la Cabada started his own law firm, focusing on criminal and regulatory law. He has been practicing law for more than 29 years.

Ramon de la Cabada has taught courses for several law enforcement agencies and the IRS. Mr. de la Cabada has instructed prosecutors and defense attorneys on jury trials, advanced trial and litigation, and anti-corruption in various Latin American countries. He also served as an expert for the U.S. Department of the Treasury in the Dominican Republic providing assistance to rewrite money laundering laws.

He received a JD from Florida State University's College of Law in 1991 and passed the Florida Bar Exam that same year. Mr. Ramon de la Cabada is a member of the Board of Directors for the National Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers and member of the Florida Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers.
