Officer Shannon Wintruba (Ret.) began her career in 1996 as a paramedic with Homestead Emergency Medical Services in Pennsylvania. In 1997, she began concurrent service with the Swissvale Borough Police Department. Wintruba left Homestead Emergency Medical Services in 2003 and the Swissvale Police Department a year later. In 2010, Wintruba returned to policing with the Whitaker Police Department and served for four more years before an injury forced her to medically retire and serve in an administrative role.

Officer Wintruba holds a BS in Legal Studies from Kaplan University, a MS in Legal Studies from the California University of Pennsylvania, and a PhD in criminal justice and safety studies from Capella University.
