Kristin Daley is the Executive Director of New Blue, a nationwide police reform incubator focused on changing police culture through impactful, sustainable policies and practices that prioritize equity and empathy. Prior to joining New Blue, Kristin served as Director of Development & Communications for the Law Enforcement Action Partnership. She spent 16 years on the LEAP staff, playing a critical role in its growth from a grassroots organization into a leading voice for

justice reform. In 2023, she became an Executive Board Member on LEAP's Board of Directors.

Kristin is a highly respected communications and development strategist specializing in sexual violence, survivor-centric crisis response, and justice system transformation. She is also a nationally credentialed victim advocate (CA) through the National Organization of Victim Assistance and a longtime crisis response counselor and liaison for RAINN's National Sexual Assault Hotline. In 2022, Kristin was appointed to the Peace Corps Sexual Assault Advisory Council, a panel of national experts in the field of sexual violence prevention and response, and serves as Chair of the 2023 Council. She has completed extensive training on crisis response, trauma, sexual harassment policy, bystander intervention, mindfulness and vicarious trauma for first responders, and officer-involved sexual and domestic violence. Kristin trains and consults nationally on victim advocacy best practices and communications strategy. She holds a BA in Communications and Media Production from Northeastern University.
