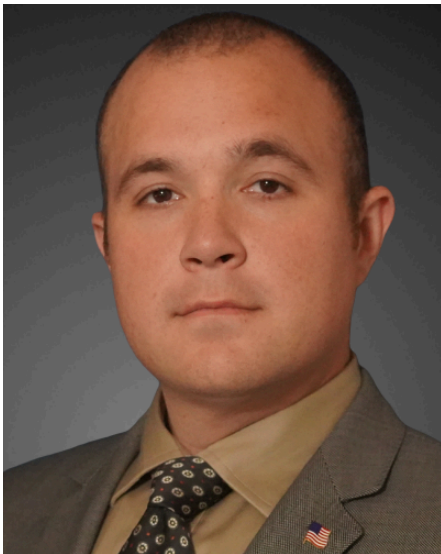

Major Dylan Hager (Ret.) began his law enforcement career in 2013 as a Correctional Officer for the Colorado Department of Corrections. In 2018 he began working as a Shift Supervisor at both Trinidad and San Carlos Correctional Facilities. In 2021 Hager moved to the Fremont Correctional Facility, where he worked as a Captain. In this position, he was responsible for overseeing the Close Custody and Restrictive Housing daily operations, security, and inmate care at the 1600-bed facility. His collaborative leadership, strengthened by an exceptional team, drove progress, advocated for mental health support, and supported the facility through significant crisis management and staffing challenges.

Hager returned to the Trinidad Correctional Facility in 2023 to serve as Major. In this role, he managed facility operations, administrative services, educational and recreational programs, and volunteer services. He also guided major initiatives for facility-wide programs aimed at reintegration and rehabilitation of offenders.

Since 2025, Hager has been an Addiction Recovery and Psychedelic Integration Coach. He has assisted numerous individuals, including veterans and first responders, in integrating their psychedelic experiences, providing pre- and post-session support to help others navigate through their own journeys with mental health or addiction. He is a certified Transformational Coach specializing in mental health, addiction recovery, and personal development.
